Minutes of the May 2016 GPLA General Membership Meeting

The May 2016 GPLA General Membership Meeting was held at the GPLA Headquarters on May 16, 2016 and was called to order at 7:30 PM by President Barry Wilensky.

President Orvis Kline stated that a quorum has not been met.

Residing Sergeant at Arms Orvis Kline lead us off with the **Pledge of Allegiance**.

President Barry Wilensky welcomed the following guests John Kieffer from Mul-T-Lock and Sven Hellwig Jr.

Previous Meeting Minutes: Murray Bilker made a motion to accept the previous minutes as printed with a 2nd by Dana Barnum and was passed unanimously.

Treasurer's Report: Marty Arnold stated that the treasurer's report was presented to the Board of Directors on May 9, 2016 for the months of March and April and was unanimously approved with minor corrections. Marty also reminded all in attendance that any member in good-standing may request a copy of the financial statement upon request. Marty also stated that he mailed in the 2015 taxes for the GPLA Association.

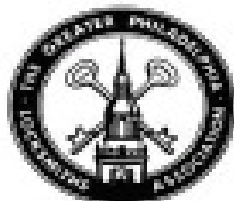
