Minutes of the November 2019 GPLA General Membership Meeting

The November 2019 GPLA General Membership Meeting was held at the GPLA Headquarters on November 21, 2019 and was called to order at 7:40 PM by President Paul Kline.

Sergeant at Arms Jack Magee lead us off with the Pledge of Allegiance.

President Paul Kline welcomed our guests, Jim Handschuh Jr. from Trine Access Technology, Darren Essen from Darren Essen Locksmiths and Neal Rose a guest of Darren Essen. He added a quorum was met and tonight is election night.

Everyone thanked Chef Sven Hellwig for bringing in another incredibly delicious meal, this time a complete Thanksgiving dinner including a roasted turkey and all the trimmings.

Program: Jim Handschuh Jr. from Trine Access Technology gave another very educational presentation on the Trine “One Box Solution” door strikes and latches.

Previous Meeting Minutes: Joe Reustle made a motion to accept the previous minutes as published in the Newsletter with a second by Sven Hellwig.
