Presidents Address – October 2020

My son is our hero.

On October 7th at 7:02 pm my daughter in-law, 29 years of age, had a cardiac arrest, her heart stopped beating and she was not breathing and no pulse. She collapsed and fell to the floor. With God's grace my son Sven Jr. was home in the other room, he heard the loud sound of her fall, as he lifted her into his arms he checked and saw no vital signs. He then cried out his adrenalin surged and he went right into action, as if automatically the CPR training he received as a Boy Scout over 17 years ago prompted him to begin chest compressions and mouth to mouth lifesaving breaths, while a friend called 911. He continued chest compressions until she gasped for air. Her heart started to beat again, but very rapidly.

First Responders arrived in 7 minutes, shocking her 2 times to bring her heart into standard rhythm. She was rushed to St. Mary's hospital where they induced a coma, connected her to a ventilator and began to cool her core body temperature to 32 degrees C for 24 hours, then they rewarmed her very slowly. It was 4 days of agony not knowing. With much prayer, hope and love she awoke very disoriented, scared and distraught, could barely speak but recognized Sven Jr, thank God.

All of the EMT's, nurses and doctors said that without Sven Jr's heroic actions, Laura would not be alive today. Her condition is a birth heart defect which she has had all of her life unrecognized. It is called Prolong QT. Laura has a long road in front of her with the need of several operations to install a defibrillator, as the condition is inoperable and can only be treated. **Continued next page**

I will make my case of importance and make a motion at the next meeting of GPLA to cover a greatly discounted group rate that I have already obtained, so that we all may someday be able to save a life! I thank you all for your prayers and positive thoughts for Laura's' speedy and full recovery.
