FROM MARTY'S COLLECTION

On one of my trips to Holland one of my locksmith friend had a Jewel money chest with a lost combination. He asked me if I could open it for him. Not knowing the kind of lock I was up against, I looked around in his showroom and saw an identical unit. After inspecting it I told him Yes I can, but I want that lock when I am done. No problem he said, I can easily get a replacement from the factory.


The lock was an Italian Sercass open case lock with three wheels and a hidden fence. The dial showed 120 numbers with the red numbers obviously being the drop in zone. I set the red 00 at the index and drilled a 3/16 hole at the red 10 outside the dial. The hard plate was not difficult to penetrate and the hole gave me a clear view of the wheels with a 90° scope, but could I not locate the drive wheel gate.

Taking exact readings on the dial index when each gate appeared, I came up with a three number combination. I dialed that combination to the index minus 10 numbers, then 9 numbers and continued dropping one number at the time, after a few tries it opened and the first ting I did was remove the lock.

My Friend Pete was very happy, and I got myself a Sercass combination lock for my collection.











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
