THE MEMBERSHIP MEETING Scheduled for Monday January 17, Has been Canceled





MOSLER LOCKS BY ILCO


Since the founding of Mosler Safe in 1867, they have been manufacturing safes and designing their own safe locks. In August of 1993 that all changed. Their lock production plants were closed and dismantled. They were the last of the great safe manufactures who had produced locks for their exclusively use in their safes. All the other safe companies had already stopped making combination locks and were using either S&G, LaGard products.


The last prominent combination lock made by Mosler was the 302 Series. It was the first Mosler lock to conform to the 'foot print' of the other lock manufacturers. Prior lock case configurations were exclusively for the Mosler safe. The need to replace a worn or damaged Mosler lock offered the safe technician little choice — another Mosler lock. The attempt to install an S&G lock for example, proved to be tedious and an impractical task.

Over the years, Mosler produced a variety of safe locks. The more common were the 120, B6, 64, 101, 103, 107, 301, 607 series. Many of these locks had model variations and were either a hand or key change function. It took a lot of research by the Safe Technician to be sure of the lock behind a Mosler safe door! The two largest safe manufactures in the U.S. were Diebold and Mosler. In the beginning, they both designed and produced their own safe locks. Today, Diebold uses LaGard locks and the basic Mosler safe line is equipped with the Ilco brand.

The Ilco 67 and 68 Series are the locks used by Mosler --- with a slight alteration. The lock bolt in Mosler 302 series retracts flush to the face of the lock case. All of the locks by S&G, LaGard and Ilco, the bolt protrudes about an eight of an inch when in the unlocked position. If one of these locks were installed into a Mosler safe, a handle cam may not have sufficient clearance to pass the lock bolt.

To allow the Ilco lock to retract the lock bolt fully to the end of the case, a modification was made in the lever. Photo 'A' is the standard Ilco 67 Series, Group-2. The 68 Series, Group 2M, both three and four-wheel are also modified for Mosler use






